

ATDC Integrated Campus, Chhindwara gets Hostel Blocks for Boys & Girls- Inaugurated by Secretary Textiles, MOT, GOI.

The ATDC Chhindwara Integrated Campus had much to cheer as Secretary Textiles inaugurated Hostel Blocks for Boys & Girls recently in the presence of Hon'ble Sri Virender Uppal, Chairman, AEPC/ATDC/IAM, Sri Hari Kapoor, Vice Chairman, ATDC, Dr Darlie Koshy, DG & CEO, ATDC & IAM, Sri HKL, Magu, Chairman, F & B AEPC, Sri Sanjeev Singh, Collector, Chhindwara, Ms. Tanvi Sundriyal, CEO, Jila Panchayat, Chhindwara and other local officials and LMC members.

The hostel for boys and girls is spread over 10000 sq. ft. having facility for stay arrangement of 21 boys and 21 girls at a time and it will be extend up to 60 candidates i.e. 30 boys and 30 girls in the coming time (as needed).
