

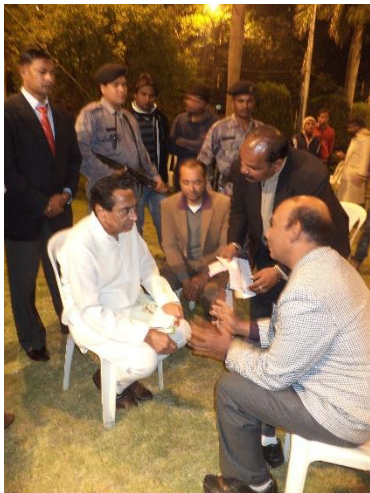
Connecting rural youth- Visit of Hon'ble Union Minister Sri Kamal Nath at ATDC Imlikhera, Chhindwara



In a show of solidarity in the ATDC-led skilling movement in Madhya Pradesh, Hon'ble Union Urban Development Minister Shri Kamal Nath visited ATDC Chhindwara Integrated Campus at Imlikhera and distributed appointment letters to the candidates who secured jobs at the Centre's Hunar Se Rozgar programme recently. Pratibha Syntex Pvt. Ltd., Pithampur, offered jobs to 45 candidates at the Rozgar Mela.



The astounding growth of enrolment in ATDC courses grabbed the attention of Union Minister for Urban Development Kamal Nath as he flipped through a copy of ATDC Annual Review at his residence after his visit.



ATDC team briefed the minister about the work of ATDC in the field of skilling. Shri Nath said that with ATDC providing NCVT (National Council for Vocational Training) approved courses and state-of-the-art training facilities, the rural youths would get access to similar training facilities available in major cities. In Chhindwara, ATDC plans to teach skills to at least one member from a family so that unemployment can be eradicated and they plan to mobilise resources to achieve this daunting task.
