ABOUT THE PROJECTS:-

REC Foundation has sponsored a project under their CSR initiative for ATDC Employment Linked Vocational Training to the unemployed/underprivileged youth belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Women/Minority/Economically weaker section at various ATDC centres located in 14 states Pan-India. REC Foundation sponsored 1100 candidates in 780 hrs. Production Supervisor-Sewing (PSS) course, 420 hrs. Sampling Coordinator/GCT course and 330 hrs. Sewing Machine Operator (SMO) course at the various ATDC Centres Pan-India. Sponsorship details given as under:-.
