ATDC Kannur takes great pleasure that M/s. ATDC Kannur was fortunate enough to avail the REC Scholarship and enrolled 25 candidates for the same. The enrolment was done after an entrance examination and 2 rounds of interviews with the selection committee.

An orientation session was delivered to the students where the students had an introductory session after inauguration, faculty introduction, briefing on the subjects, conduct of practical and theory sessions, mark allotments, importance of attendance, and other important matters. The candidates were also distributed 2 Tshirts each.












PROJECT BASED VISIT

As part of the Partial fulfillment of B.Voc FDR Sem 1 curriculum, a craft visit was organized from ATDC Kannur, for the students of 1st semester B.Voc FDR – REC and direct batches.

The one day visit was organized to SARGALAYA – ARTS AND CRAFTS VILLAGE located at Vadakara, Kozhikode district on 10.10.2023.

The craft village is located approximately 88 km from ATDC Kannur.

- We started by 9:00 am , and reached the venue by 11:30 am on 10th Oct 2023.
- The students were given a brief about the craft village, its importance in preserving the traditional craft heritage and assigned individual topics group wise for report preparation.
- The visit was completed along with students visiting each stall, where the artisans explained the students about each craft, where students clicked pictures and noted down the details.
- We spent around 4 hours understanding about 27 craft varieties.
- Lunch was arranged in the Sargalaya canteen in between the visit for all students.






































TIE and DYE WORKSHOP
